## Policies & Procedures

---

- The GAS art grant budget is based upon the previous year's net income from Gateway Burners' events, fundraisers and donations.
- Grants are intended to cover materials and transportation and not intended to cover labor costs.
- Funding requests for renovations or extensions of existing projects are allowed and can be submitted.
- Performances are eligible. Pretty much anything is eligible.
- Funds will be distributed within 30 days of successful execution and display of the project.
- Artists should indicate whether their project can be taken elsewhere. There will be additional judging points for taking the piece to additional locations.
- Gateway Art Support retains ownership of any work created by these grants. The artist(s) may be asked to steward the responsibility of maintaining the work and its further benefit to the Burning Man Community.
- Unallocated art funds will roll over into the following year.
- Artists must provide photos, write a short summary and agree to release the same for publicity purposes, including but not limited to Gateway Burners' website. Failure to do so may result in award reduction.
- Gateway Burners and/or Gateway Art Support reserves the right to reproduce any and all imagery related to the Gateway Burn for promotional purposes only. All reasonable attempts will be made to give proper credit to the artists involved.

**What is Gateway Art Support?** Gateway Art Support (GAS) is the art sector of Gateway Burners. Gateway Burners is an organization created to foster radical self-expression, radical inclusion, participatory art, and sustainable community as well as encouraging civic responsibility through regional events, information sharing and education for the community in Saint Louis and its surrounding areas. GAS is pleased to announce the availability of art grants intended to help defray the costs of materials and transportation related to creating and presenting works of art at Gateway Burn.

**Where does the grant money come from?** Gateway Burners is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. The art grants that GAS awards are primarily funded through various fundraising efforts and generous donations from the St. Louis community. In the future, GAS plans to continue to increase the GAS awards for art projects via external grants and appeals to other sources.

MARCH 1, 2012.**

## Art Grants

---

Gateway Art Support (GAS) Grants are awarded in amounts ranging from \$50 to \$500 and intended as supplementary funding to help give birth to your proposed final project. The GAS Committee reserves the right to award less than the requested grant(s) amount based on completion milestones. The balance of the grant(s) will be awarded within 30 days after successful execution and display of the proposed project.

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following (in no particular order):

- **Quality**  
creativity / interactivity / thoughtfulness / originality / excitement / inspiration
- **Execution**  
planning / feasibility / safety plan / clean-up plan / budget / past work
- **Principles**  
reflection of the "10 principals" of Burning Man
- **Theme**  
how or if the work supports the Art Theme of the event

## Responsibilities

---

Grant winners will sign a contract stating their intent to:

1. create the proposed project;
2. present the project;
3. provide photos and a short follow-up report for publicity purposes; and
4. include the phrase "Funded in part by the Gateway Burn's Gateway Art Support (GAS)" on any and all promotional materials.

The GAS Committee will carefully review your application and notify you in a timely manner. Do not be discouraged if you are not awarded a grant. We have limited funds and are forced to make tough decisions about where to apply them.
